Tips to Help You Beat the Summer Heat

Insulate – Insulation reduces the amount of heat that enters your home from outside. In a well insulated house, less energy is consumed battling heat conducted in from the outside through walls and ceilings.

Seal up air leaks – A tightly sealed home reduces the amount of warm air that leaks into your home from outside.

Use shades to prevent the “greenhouse effect” – Closing window shades during the day will prevent sunlight from entering your home and heating it up, decreasing the load on your cooling equipment.

Ceiling fan – A ceiling fan cools in summer by circulating air. The air temperature is not reduced, but people feel cooler due to the breeze.

Turn thermostats up a few degrees – Instead of cooling your home to 72 degrees F, try 75 or 78 degrees F. Every degree you increase the thermostat setting reduces the load on your cooling system.

Cool only the spaces you are in – Zone your HVAC system so you cool only the areas you are in.

Change or clean filters - Clean filters increase the airflow and efficiency of air conditioning equipment.
